PA's Comprehensive Anti-Human Trafficking Law

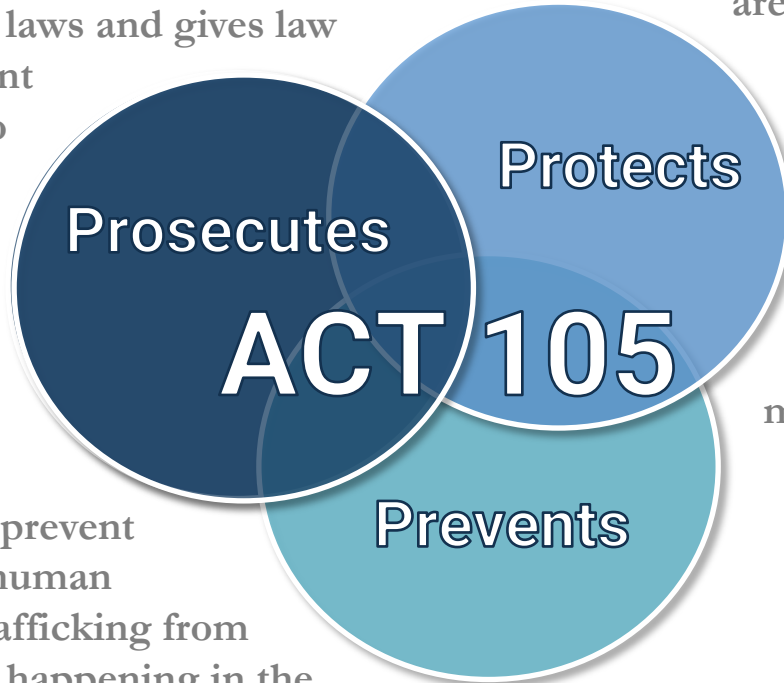
18 Pa. Cons. Stat. §§ 3001 – 3072 (2014).

Act 105

expands current PA human trafficking laws and gives law enforcement the tools to go after traffickers

Survivors of human trafficking are eligible for

protections such as expunging records, rehabilitation program, confidential case management, and civil legal remedies



To prevent human trafficking from happening in the first place, Act 105 works to develop, expand or strengthen programs for victims of human trafficking and increase public awareness
